### **Selection Process for Applicants**

Candidates to the program will be assessed on their academic achievement, the results of their portfolio and questionnaire, and participation in an information session.

Applicants selected for the program will be notified by mail and their Sheridan email account. These decisions will not be released over the phone. Fee, registration and timetable information will follow. Classes for the fall term begin Tuesday, September 4, 2012.

### **Instructions for Applicants**

In order that we can continue to process your application, you must:

**Register online for IN-PERSON Portfolio Evaluation. Applicants will be given specific instructions.**

Your portfolio gives you an opportunity to display your ability to follow instructions accurately and provides us with insight into your problem-solving abilities.

The portfolio should contain 10 to 12 pieces of your strongest work. It should contain mostly photographs; however, drawings/sketches, paintings and/or other artistic media, may be submitted as photographic prints. We are not looking for technical perfection. We are looking for artistic potential and the ability to take on a variety of subjects (i.e., portraits, landscapes, still life etc.).

### **Please note:**

Submit your work as photographic prints; photocopies or framed work are not accepted and will not be evaluated. Images submitted on CD/DVD or online will not be considered.

### **Only your own work must be submitted**

You must **also** submit a sheet featuring thumbnails of all your portfolio images. As an alternative to thumbnails, you may submit colour or b&w photocopies of the images contained in your portfolio. Please submit these thumbnails or photocopies in a separate envelope labeled with your name and student ID number. The thumbnails or photocopies will not be evaluated but will be retained in our files and not returned.

Enclose the essay as noted below

Essay: Please submit a maximum 250 word statement of intent detailing your photographic experience so far, your professional goals as a photographer, and how choosing Sheridan's BAA (Photography) would help you attain those goals.
